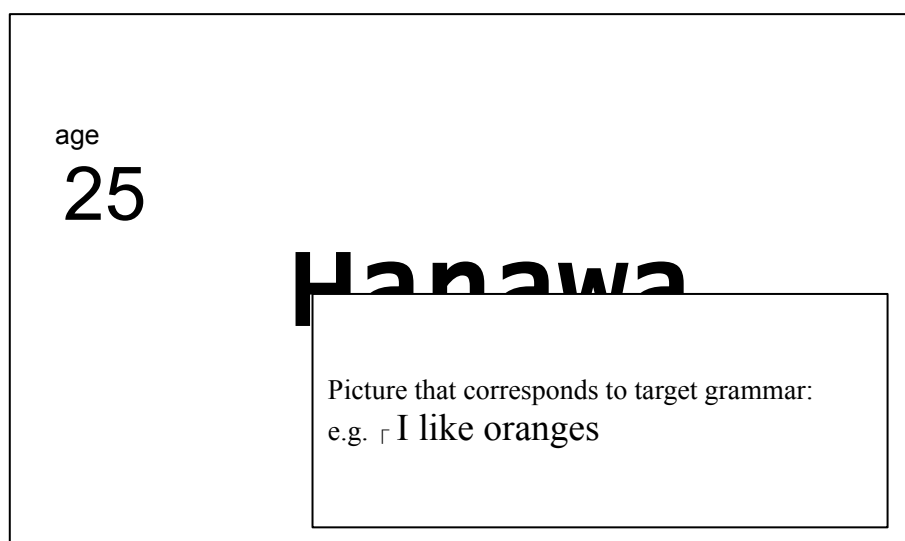
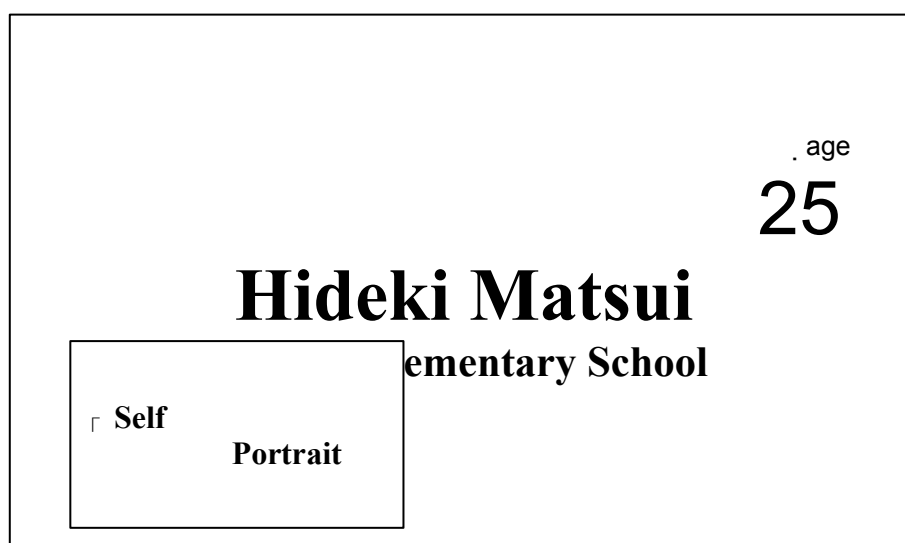


# Elementary school lesson plan

## The Meishi Game

During your time in Japan, I'm sure you've received your fair share of business cards. Well, just like their adult counterparts, Japanese children too love the chance to exchange these little identity cards, which can really be capitalized upon to review what you have already taught and even to practice new structures. Get the kids to make up 6 cards. I've included a few examples below



The activity consists of the kids giving their self-introduction in pairs, including any additional target language, e.g. I like....., I play.....

They then play Jan Ken, and the winner receives a business from the loser. The overall winner is the student with the most business cards, who is destined for a career as a salary man and can look forward to a future of commuting on a crowded train in rush hour Tokyo.
