Type of Activity: Board Game








Materials: Dice, Counters, Board (an enlarged copy of the attached sheet on a cardboard backing will suffice)

This lesson plan is appropriate for 3rd Grade students and is a good way to use your traveling experiences in the classroom. The nature of this activity means that it's most effective in small numbers.

Begin by reading a story about your trip and then allow them to ask some questions. Introduce the board and distribute the counters. Let the game begin!

If you want to try this activity with larger classes, you can divide the students into groups and have several games running simultaneously.
